### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

I can't believe that we are half way through Term 3 already! This term we have participated and engaged in a variety of activities and still have a number of exciting opportunities to come.

We, as a school, would like to acknowledge the significant work that families do to contribute to your child/ren's education. This year we have improved in a number of areas that we focused on at the beginning of the year. Each day around 95% of students are bringing their Daily Diary, 98% of students are in correct uniform and 94% of students are arriving to school on time and ready to learn. 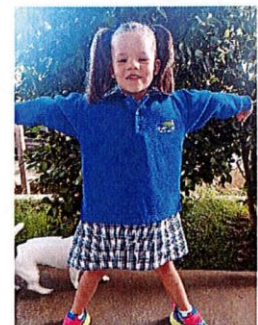


## Father's Day Stall
