PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

SCIENCE WEEK

Last week we celebrated Science Week. All students, in all classes, participated in a variety of experiments and exciting activities. Miss Vince organised the team from Earth Ed to come in and work with our Years 3-6 students around coding 'Sphero Balls'. The students had to code their ball to navigate themselves around 'Jurassic Park'. The engagement level was high and at times, so were the frustration levels when they were being chased by a T-Rex! Earth Ed are a fantastic resource that are based at Mount Clear College.

Our Foundation students observed what happens to celery when it is dipped in food colouring. They had to predict what would happen and then make notes on what was happening daily. After a few days the leaves changed to the colour of the food colouring. The wondering the students had was the celery that was dipped in yellow food colouring. They couldn't see any change.

It was great to see how the students in Year 5/6 worked together to develop 'rockets'. The students had to design, plan and then build a rocket. The students tested their rockets using air pumps (provided by Earth Ed) to see if their design would be sent to NASA. There was a mixture of results.

All the students watched The NED Show recently. The show's theme was around a positive mindset and overcoming challenges. NED went on an expedition to work on his mindset. During his adventures he understood what his name meant; Never give up, Encourage others, Do your best!
