CURRICULUM DAY: BERRY ST EDUCATION MODEL – RELATIONSHIP

All staff spent Monday 4th September engaged in the second module of the Berry Street Education Model. The module was around relationships and how we can build positive relationships with all children, always. We spent the day unpacking strategies that related to relationships. Relationships are formed through deliberate steps taken by carers, teachers, and staff that establish trust, validation, and safety.

The one area I found very interesting was on 'Process Praise vs Person Praise and the difference between the two.

Person praise is vague, describes the teacher's feelings, can seem untrue or manipulative to students. *'This is great!', 'You did that very well.'* *'I just love that's.*

Process praise is very specific, describes the student's effort, and is seen as true by the student. *'You finished that!', 'You stayed in your seat the whole time.'*

Our aim is to use more process praise with students as it provides more detail as to what they have done well.

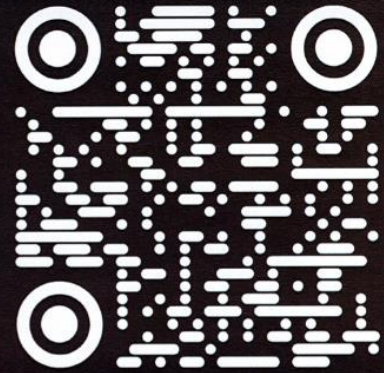
