INCURSIONS – BEC'S BEES & ROBOTICS

Our students in years 1-6 have engaged in a number of incursions over the last few weeks. The 1/2s had a visit from a Bec's Bees and learnt a lot about the importance of bees. The students were very engaged and used the following recess times to explore our gardens looking for bees. They were very surprised to how many they found.

The year's 3-6 students engaged with the Melbourne Museum Tech team to learn code. The students used coding to move mBots (mini robots) around the room and through mazes they created. It was fascinating to watch these little robots follow the commands of our students.

We had our first Fun Friday! We had a variety of activities running and students were able to sign up to an activity of their choice. We had students cooking, making playdo, reading, painting and dancing amongst other activities. The response from the students was very positive. 
