PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

WEARABLE ART PARADE

Our Year 5/6 students have been engaged in an arts project over the last 14 weeks. We had applied for a Creative Learning Partnership grant to do a wearable art project following the theme of 'Be The Change You Want To See.' Mrs Quach and the 5/6 students were joined in the art room by resident artist, Anzara Clark. The students worked in small groups to create garments out of recycled material and link them to an issue they see in our society.

Our student's understanding of a variety of social issues is amazing. Students presented their outfits on a variety of topics including racism, equality, environmental impacts, homelessness and social justice. The students paraded their outfits for a variety of dignitaries and many members of our parent community. The parade was held at the Rare Trades Centre.

A big thanks to Mrs Quach who implemented the project and Anzara for bringing her passion of wearable art.

The feedback from Arts Victoria was that it was an exemplar project and they will be sharing our approach with other schools who receive grants.

STUDENT LEADERSHIP 2024
