Parent/Teacher/Student Meetings

Our Parent/Teacher/Student Meetings will be held on Tuesday next week. Students are only required to attend school on this day for their meeting with their family. Bookings are available between 11am and 7pm and can be made on Compass – please contact the office if you need assistance with this. We strongly encourage all families to attend.

Parking

We have been contacted by Ballarat Council and have been asked to pass on the following information regarding parking directly in front of the office on the service road:

The Council Parking Services remind everyone that if there is a 'No Parking' sign, you can stop for 2 minutes in that area if you are picking up or dropping off passengers or goods. You must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle.

As this is an ongoing concern, the Council wish to give parents and carers a reminder to do the right thing. If further issues arise, patrols and enforcement will be undertaken by council officers resulting in fines being issued.

We understand how busy the service road is at drop off and pick up times. We ask our school community to be patient and abide by the parking signs which helps us ensure the safety of all students and our school community.

COVID Requirements

There continue to be a number of COVID requirements that we do need to follow to keep everyone safe. Many of these have been extended for the remainder of Term 1. All staff and students in years 3 – 6 continue to be required to wear a mask indoors. Please ensure your child has a mask each day.

Rapid Antigen Tests have been provided to all students. The expectation is that each student will take a **R.A.T. test** twice a week for the remainder of the school term. A new box for each student will be distributed this week.

Where a positive result is recorded by a student on rapid antigen test, their parent/carers or student must report that result to the Department of Health via the [Self Reporting Form](#) or call centre on 1800 675 398. The parent/carers or student must also report the result directly to the school, preferably using the new [RA Test Portal](#) or by a written note or phone call to the school.

QR Code check ins are no longer necessary for parents/carers when entering the school site. Masks must still be worn in all indoor spaces (unless a valid exemption applies).

We will continue to keep families informed as changes occur.

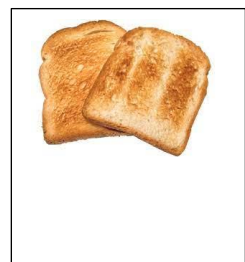
