#### PRINCIPAL'S CONFERENCE - MELBOURNE

Next week I will be attending the Principal's Conference in Melbourne. This will be the first opportunity for Principals to attend the face to face conference in two years. The conference is a fantastic way to learn from other schools and worldwide educational leaders. Dr Murrell, Mrs Nash and Mr Cooper will be attending aspects of the conference online. I look forward to sharing my highlights in the next newsletter.

#### **RAPID ANTIGEN TESTS - TERM 2**

Schools will continue to be provided with the same weekly quantity of rapid antigen tests (RATs).

However, from Monday 23 May 2022, it is recommended RATs are used by students and staff when symptomatic. RATs are also required to be used for 5 days if a student or staff member is a close contact of a confirmed case and they are attending or working at a school.

From that time, it will no longer be recommended that non-symptomatic students or staff conduct tests with RATs twice a week in mainstream schools, (or 5 days a week in specialist schools).

Students and staff must continue to notify the Department of Health and their school if they return a positive RAT result.

Vaccination remains the best way to protect students and staff in school settings and your ongoing support in encouraging children aged 5 to 11 to get vaccinated and staff and 16 to 17-year-olds to get their third dose remains critical.
