PRINCIPALS CONFERENCE

Last week I had the opportunity to attend the Education State Principal's Conference. The theme of the conference was 'Stronger Together: Every Student, Every School'. There were a number of keynote speakers who addressed the school leaders. Listening to Graeme Innes AM speak about inclusion in society was extremely interesting. He led the merger of four blindness agencies to become Vision Australia. Graeme is extremely passionate about inclusion and supporting all people.

I walked away with a number of wonderings after his presentation. Are we an inclusive school? What can we do to improve inclusion at our school? Am I an inclusive leader? These are the wonderings I will speak to staff, parents and students about as I further develop my understanding of what inclusion is.

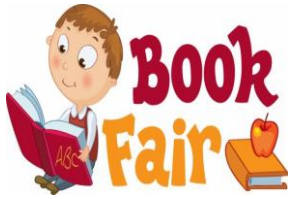
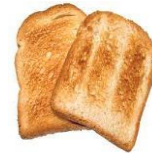
